

**** UPDATED COVID GUIDELINES ****

As of September 14, the Covid guidelines are changing and as a pub, we want to make sure we keep all our customers and employees safe.

From 14 September, we will only be able to seat 2 households at 1 table of up to 6 people. This does not apply if you are coming in as 1 household and have more than 6 people i.e. a household of 7 people.

If you want a larger table of 2 households i.e. a table of 8, you will have to sit on 2 tables, 1m+ apart. This also means that you cannot get up move around and stand at the other table. You must remain seated at your table.

Outside, we can accommodate parties of up to 6 households but only on 1 table of 6. Any more than that and they have to be on different tables spaced 1m+ apart.

From September 18, it is a legal requirement for pubs to take part in track and trace.

If you are 2 households inside we just need name and phone number of 1 person from each household. If you are multiples households sat outside we will need names and numbers of each individual.

Details will be kept for a mandatory 21 days. This is a legal requirement from September 18.

Please help us to help you and our staff stay safe by complying with the new guidelines.
